

Grant Description:

Applications will only be accepted seeking support to expand existing MSW <u>programs</u>. No applications will be accepted that seek funding for New BSW/BASW or New MSW Programs. Only public universities will be eligible to apply for MSW enrollment expansion this year. Enrollment will be limited to students seeking a career as a licensed clinician to serve children and youth through ages 25.

HCAI is offering a one-time grant opportunity of up to \$20,000,000 in available funding with no implied or expressed guarantee of subsequent funding after the initial contract award resulting from this application. HCAI may award full, partial, or no funding to an applicant based on the applicant's criteria score and the number of available funds. Eligible programs may receive funds to fill first year MSW positions, with a maximum of 25 admissions for all categories of added student slots. Funding will be available based on the type of MSW program, per student, as follows:

- a. Full and part time: \$70,000
- b. Online only students: \$40,000
- c. One-year Advanced Standing \$40,000


